Safe and Responsible Use Agreement

Our National Governing Body, England Netball, encourages all clubs and its members to use social media to positively promote their club, themselves, their achievements, and the sport of netball. However, England Netball will not tolerate anyone using social media either intentionally or by association to insult, slander, create a risk to personal safety or abuse any individual, organisation, or the sport of netball.

We ask all club members, parents/carers and people in positions of trust to read the Policy and ensure that they and/or their child/ren have understood the importance of the Policy and what is expected of them when using social media.

Yeovil Netball Club understands the importance of this issue and is committed to promoting the responsible, safe use of social media.

We expect all club members, parents and carers:

- To use social media to positively promote Yeovil Netball Club, yours and our achievements, and the sport of netball
- To never use social media to insult, belittle or criticise fellow club members, other teams, players, umpires, officials, or staff of England Netball
- To never post or give out personal details that may compromise or put at risk the personal safety of you or any other person
- To never tag or identify any club member in any photographic or recorded image in anyway relating to the club.
- To think carefully about your behaviour and language when using social media and texts relating to the club, its members and the wider netball community, including anything re-posted
- To report material, posts or contacts which you find upsetting or cause you concern to one our club Safeguarding Officers or the Chair of either the Senior or Junior section of our club.
